7. Aug 20, Women on War Reception, (expanded to six artists) co-sponsored by Peace Action Maine at the 3 Fish Gallery in Portland, Maine.
8. Sept 16, CEIA AIDs program, Zill moderating a panel of four experts in the Art Gallery at UNE, taped and broadcast on Channel 4 several times a week for a month, March 2005.
9. Sept 24, Zill Seminar for University of Maine students on Women's Leadership against the backdrop of the Women on War exhibition.
10. Nov 8, Women on War Exhibition (expanded to seven artists), College of the Atlantic Opening Reception, seminar, and press interview in Bar Harbor, Maine.
11. Dec 6, Women's Leadership Action Coalition Meetings in Augusta, ME, coordinated by Maine Women's Policy Center.
12. Dec 9, Examining the borders between Fine and Folk Art, a Symposium moderated by Zill and taped for broadcast several times a week during February, 2005 on Channel 4.
